

## COMMUNICATION MINOR OUTLINE

- 18 Units of Communication coursework is required
- COMM 101 – Intro to the Study of COMM, is required for all minors
- 9 of the 18 units must be **Upper Division (Courses numbered 300-499)**
- 9 of the 18 units must be COMM Skills
- 3 units must be completed at the University of Arizona
- Student must earn a 2.0 GPA in the minor to graduate
- During Fall and Spring semesters, Communication minors only have access to the COMM courses listed on this sheet
- Communication courses do not have pre-requisites during the Summer and Winter sessions; Communication minors may find greater course availability during those times
- Not all courses are offered each semester
- Junior class standing is recommended for **Upper Division** coursework
