Registration NOTE:

- COMM courses are restricted to declared minors with the exception of COMM 101 (Intro to the Study of Communication).
- COMM courses are popular and fill up quickly. Registration in COMM courses is *not guaranteed* and COMM Minors may have to take Summer and/or Winter courses.
- For this reason, the COMM Minor can be difficult to complete quickly. Please allow yourself enough time to complete this minor. We recommend at least 3-4 semesters.

MINOR REQUIREMENTS:

- A minimum of 18 units required and 9 of which must be Upper Division
 - Upper Division are courses numbered 300-499
- At least 3 units must be completed at the University of Arizona (in residence)
- A 2.0 minimum GPA is required in the minor to graduate
- Not ALL courses are offered each semester and vary by term
- Communication Minors need to be prepared to take Summer courses
- Summer and Winter COMM courses do not have any prerequisites
- Junior class standing is recommended for Upper Division coursework

COMMUNICATION MINOR

- Breakdown of Minor Requirements:
 - Core: 3 Units
 - Skills: 9 Units
 - COMM Electives: 6 Units

COMM Course Options

Two Electives Courses are required (6 Units - Need to be declared to enroll):

- COMM 301: Survey of Mass Communicating
- COMM 311: COMM Technology Theory
- COMM 318: Persuasion
- COMM 402: COMM & Music
- COMM 410: Struggle for the Presidency
- COMM 420: COMM & the Legal Process

COMM Course Prerequisites

COMM 101: None

COMM Skills: Must be declared COMM Minor

COMM Electives: Must be declared COMM Minor





Transfer Courses

- Transfer coursework can be used towards the Communication Minor
- At least 3 units MUST be completed at the University of Arizona
- At least 9 units MUST be Upper Division courses from a four-year institution. Junior College/Community college credits is NOT Upper Division
- Transfer Equivalents for In-State Transfers can be checked via the [Course Equivalency Guide](#)
- Transfer Equivalents for Out-of-State Transfers:
 - Transfer credit to be used in the COMM Minor needs to be evaluated by a COMM Advisor.
