- 18 units of Communication coursework required
- COMM 101, Intro to Study of COMM, is required for all minors
- 9 of the 18 units must be **upper division (course numbered 300-499)**
- 9 of the 18 units must be COMM skills
- 3 units must be completed at the University of Arizona
- Students must earn a 2.0 GPA in the minor to graduate
- During Fall and Spring semesters, Communication minors only have access to the COMM courses listed on this sheet.
- Communication courses do not have pre-requisites during Summer and Winter sessions; Communication minors may find greater course availability during those times.
- Not all courses are offered each semester
- Junior class standing is recommended for upper division coursework
